

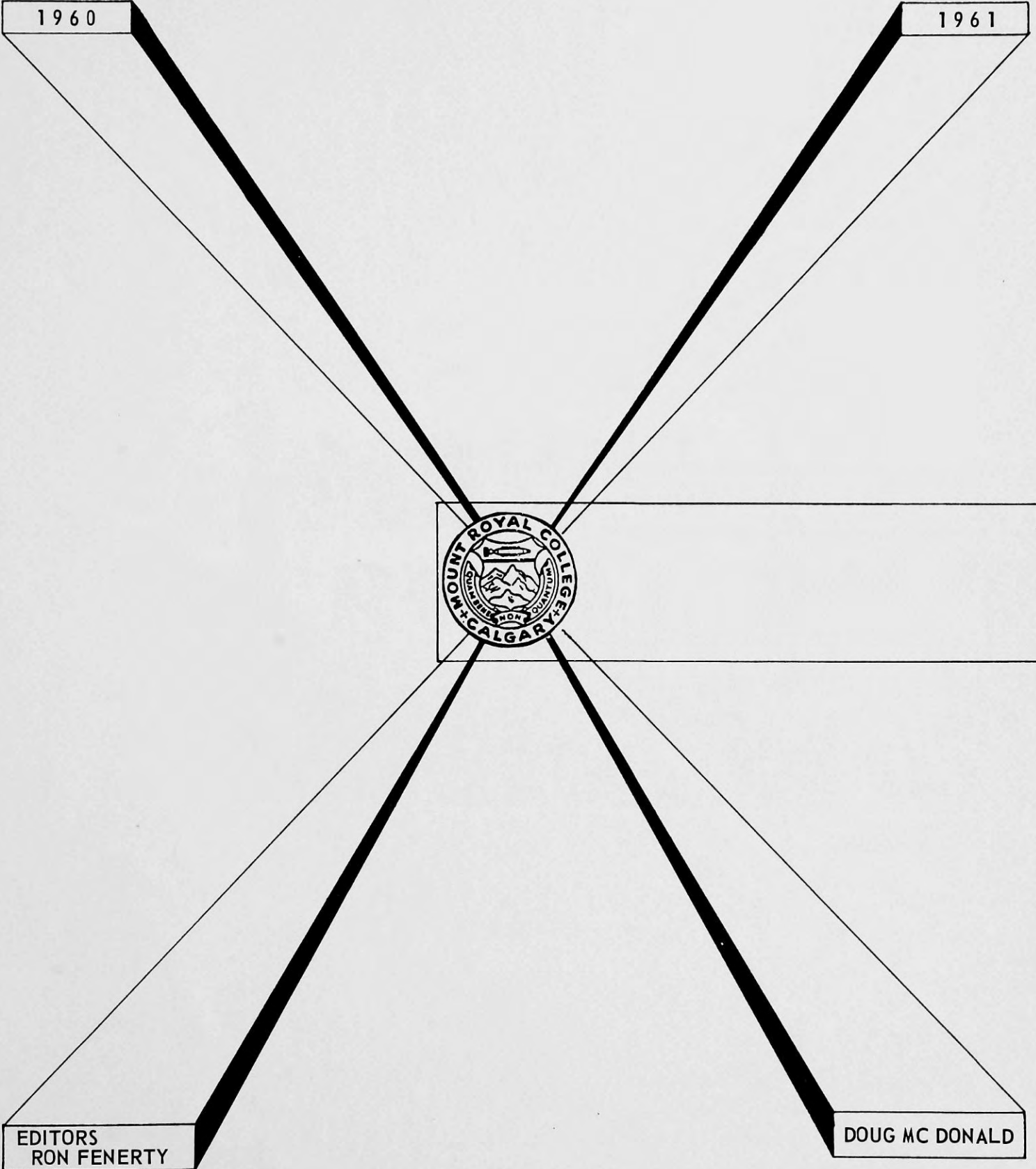

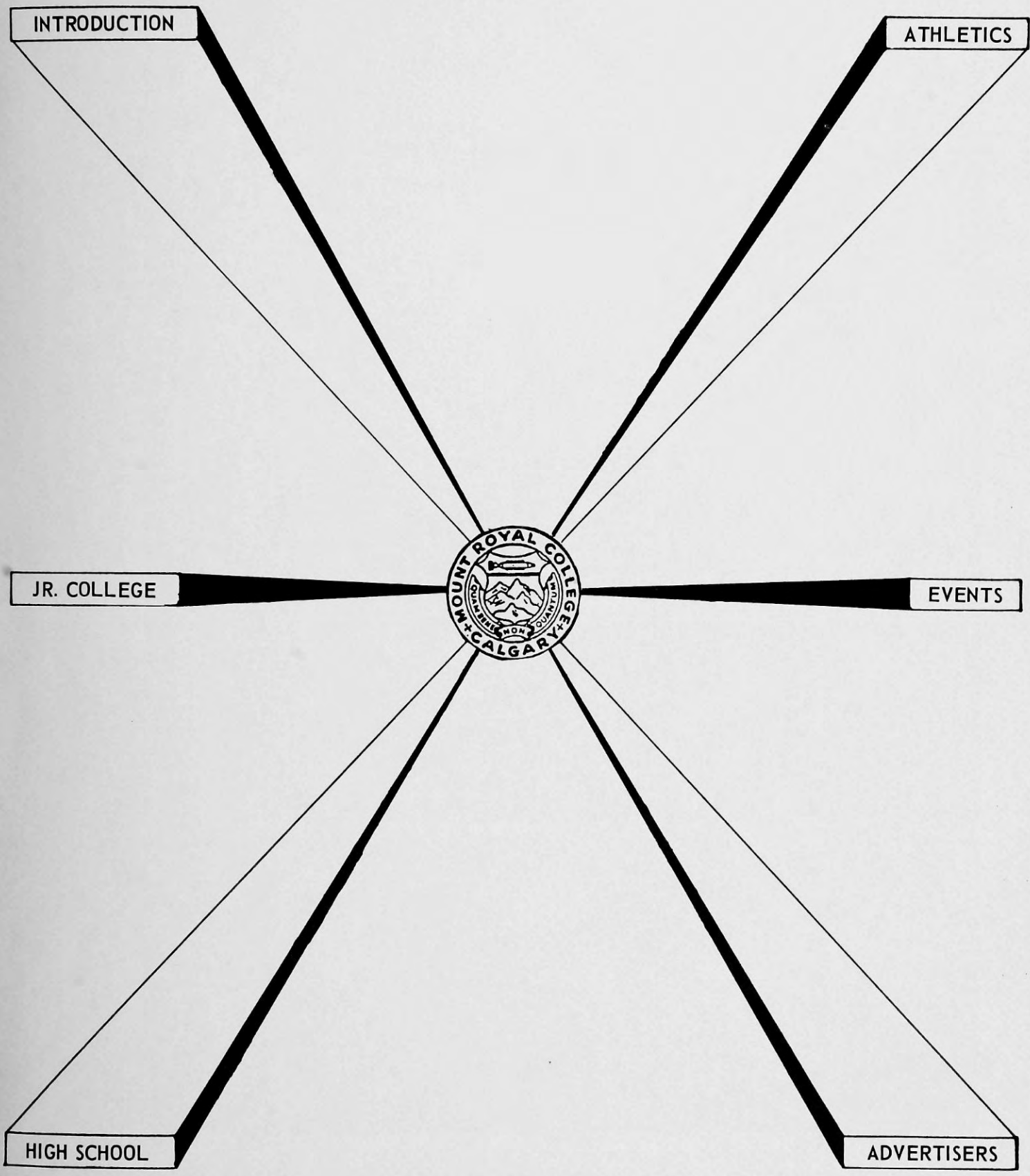

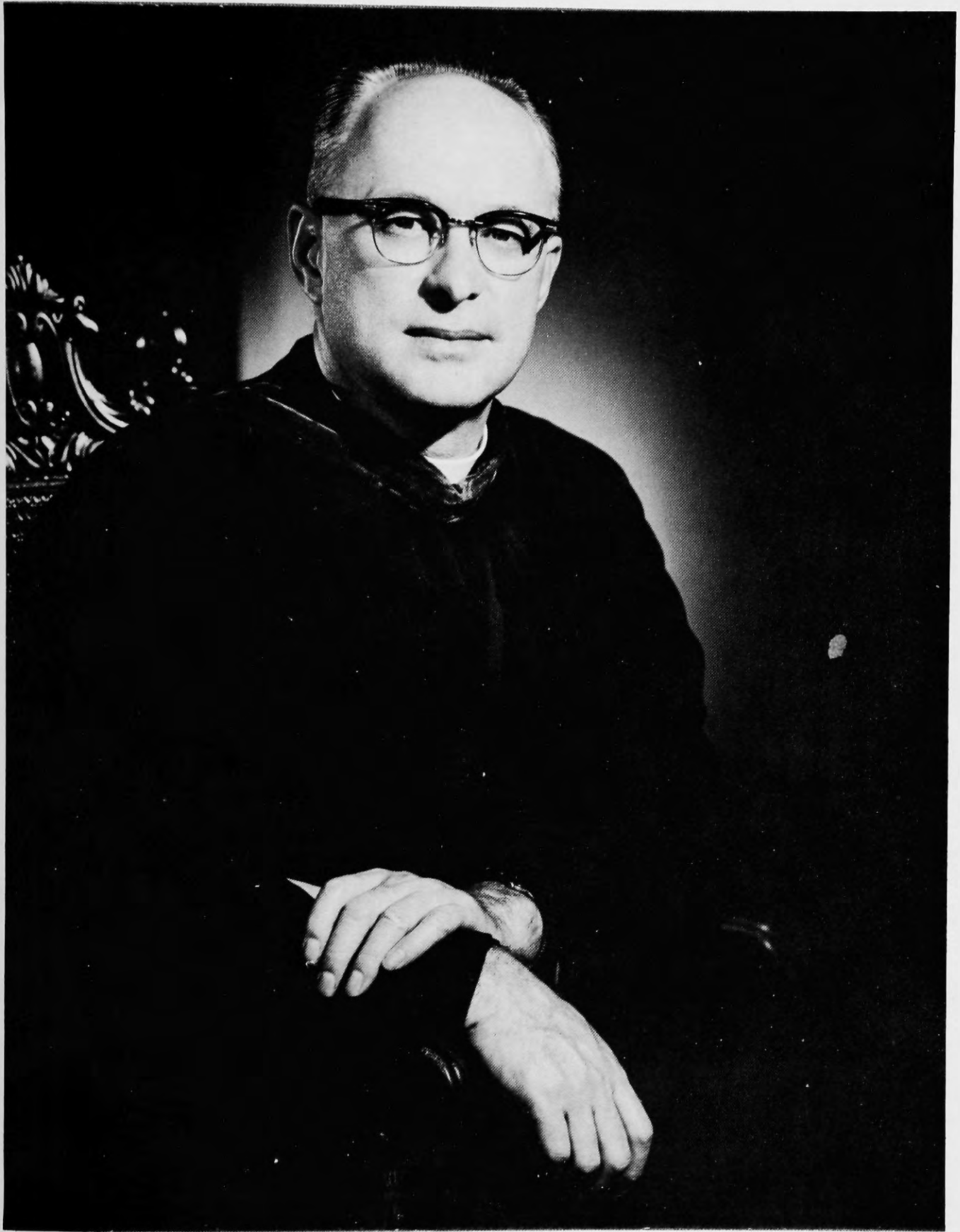

## *A Message from the Principal*

This message is being written just after the Graduation Ceremonies of Class '61, which was the Fiftieth Class to graduate from Mount Royal College. The ceremonies were of very high order and those who worked so hard to make them a success deserve great commendation. I am sure that those who took part in the various dinners, dances and ceremonies will long remember the occasions with pleasure. The Committee really did an excellent job in locating speakers. No graduating class could want more than to have the opportunity of listening to the Chairman of the Calgary Chamber of Commerce, and editor of a newspaper, the Principal of the University of Alberta, Calgary, and a member of our own Board of Governors.

Each of these men had a message to give, and each approached it from his own point of view. Yet each man attempted to impress on the graduating class that this is an era of opportunity and a time when the acceptance of responsibility for one's own future is essential.

Tolstoi once wrote, "Man's inhumanity to man stems not as much from overt action against the other person as from depriving him of what he is hoping for."

This statement is true. Man's inhumanity to man is not physical even these days of an uneasy Peace. In days of war when physical violence is evident on all sides, the mental anguish of the people who are deprived of hope is greater. Today, man's inhumanity to man is seen when freedom is snatched away from the people of Hungary and civil rights from the negro in the Southern United States. It is seen when the nations "struggling to be born" are refused the opportunity to establish their independence. The hungry, the homeless, and the refugee, all have been robbed of hope because of man's inhumanity to man.

A young person may be inhuman to himself and to those that care for him when he deliberately robs himself of the hope of making for himself a place in this world. Many young people are doing just that by neglect and carelessness.

We hope that the Graduation Class of 1961 are humanitarians in every sense of that word. This means that they care about themselves and their future and they are concerned about the welfare of all peoples. If this is so, then this Fiftieth-Graduation Class of Mount Royal College will leave its imprint on the world.

MOUNT ROYAL COLLEGE

The Mount Royal Cougar Football Team, this year helped to put Calgary back on the map as a football centre or, more specifically, as a Junior Football centre. As a result of the team's great success, the Cougars won respect for the College; a respect founded on sportsmanship, drive, earnesty and a strong will to win.

Under John Borger, a one-time professional center in his own right, the Cougars began to geld. Players who had come from various city highschools where they had been successful with their own teams, were molded into what might be termed on all star highschoool football team. We say an all star team because players such as Ro Riley, Trev Ekdahl, Larry Robinson, Bill Goods, Jack Truran, Jerry Shaw, Mike Pannett, Glen Hartley, Dennis Stiles.....had received all star honors during their highschoool careers.

Long sessions of practice, hard blocking, precision plays, and a high team spirit produced an Alberta Junior Football crown for the Cougars. The Cougar line was strong and was often called upon to stand great barrages from the opposition. The Cougar backfield was powerful. It had strength wherever and whenever it was needed. The Cougar defence was almost unbeatable.

Although many individual stars received credit for their outstanding performances, we must remember that without the backing of their team, these tributes would never have been made possible. The Cougars were a unit bent on winning, which they did.

When they became too injury-ridden to perform at their best, they played with all their heart, for they never lost their desire to win. The Cougars carried Mount Royal's colors to the semi-finals of the Canadian Junior championships by defeating the highly-rated and powerful Vancouver Blue Bombers 33-8. Only days later, they met the Canadian Junior Champions, the Saskatoon Hilltops on their home ground.

The Cougars were never unsupported, for their fans were loyal to the end. Perhaps this was one of the great incentives to the players. Nonetheless, the Cougars were defeated 23-0 by a healthier team.

The Cougars were long shots from the start. It was their first season in the league, yet they went to the semi-finals of the Canadians. They were not only the first Calgary team in six years to capture the Alberta championship, but also, they were the youngest team to ever achieve this title. The Cougars also attracted the largest crowd in Junior football history on October 23, when twelve thousand ardent supporters saw them defeat the Edmonton Huskies 33-32.

Their season is over, their memories remain with us still. They brought fame and honor to Mount Royal College. Perhaps next year, they will bring the Canadian Junior Football Trophy.
